REPORTS FROM ORGANIZATIONS / COLLEGES / DISTRICT OFFICE

Academic Senate Report – Mr. Marlon Hall, Academic Senate President at West Hills College Coalinga, provided tenure recommendations from the Senate. He reported that there are 11 individuals from West Hills College Coalinga who have completed their probationary period and are eligible for tenure. Mr. Hall also read a resolution in support of the recommendation for tenure. Mr. Hall provided a presentation on the Academic Senate for California Community Colleges for his doctoral studies.

Mr. David Rengh, Academic Senate President at West Hills College Lemoore, was not present to report at this time.

<u>WHCFA Report</u> – In the absence of Mr. John Bart, WHCFA President, Ms. Faye Mendenhall reported. She stated that the faculty association stands behind the Senate's recommendations for tenure and feels that the individuals are awesome instructors.

<u>CSEA Report</u> - Mr. Tony Garcia, CSEA President, was not present to report at this time.

<u>ASB Report</u> - Mr. Willie Lee, Student Trustee, was not present to report at this time.

<u>West Hills College Coalinga and North District Center, Firebaugh</u> – Dr. Anthony Tricoli, President, distributed a campus activities report and briefly commented on recent and upcoming events. Dr. Tricoli reported that the Hospital Peace Officer Training Academy program was developed by the Administration of Justice Department in cooperation with the Coalinga State Hospital. Dr. Beverly Smith and

Mr. John Bart have submitted the curriculum for this program and it is expected to enroll over 100 full-time students at West Hills College Coalinga each year. Dr. Tricoli announced that James Kossler will be the accreditation team chair for the upcoming visit in the spring.

<u>West Hills College Lemoore</u> – Mr. Don Warkentin, Interim President, distributed a campus activities report and briefly commented on recent and upcoming events. On behalf of Mr. Rengh, who was unable to attend the Board meeting, Mr. Warkentin announced that the Lemoore Academic Senate is recommending Shawn Jackson and Rene Sanchez for tenure. Mr. Warkentin reported that Student Trustee, Willie Lee, is currently in class but would like the Board to know that students are back on campus for the new semester and are active. An ecology club is being formed and the students are preparing for black history month in February.

Mr. Dave Bolt briefly reported on the curriculum committee report.

Mr. Warkentin reported that he is making visits to the various service groups in the Lemoore community and is giving presentations concerning West Hills College Lemoore.

<u>Chancellor's Report</u> – Dr. Frank Gornick, Chancellor, provided a brief update on the Presidential Search process for West Hills College Lemoore. The web page for the search was explained and Dr. Gornick reported that it will soon be live on the District's website.

At this time President McKean presented Trustee Levinson with a plaque on behalf of the students, employees, citizens and Board members of the West Hills Community College District in honor of his service as President of the Board of Trustees from 2001-2004.
