REPORTS FROM ORGANIZATIONS / COLLEGES / DISTRICT OFFICE

<u>Academic Senate Report</u> – Mr. Marlon Hall, Academic Senate President at West Hills College Coalinga, distributed a resolution with regard to a tenure review form. He explained that the Academic Senate in Coalinga has been given the responsibility of developing a tenure review form for the accreditation visit in March and is seeking Board approval of the form.

In the absence of Mr. David Rengh, Academic Senate President for West Hills College Lemoore, Mr. Hall presented resolutions in support of tenure for Ms. Rene Sanchez and Mr. Shawn Jackson.

<u>WHCFA Report</u> - Mr. John Bart, WHCFA President, was not present to report at this time.

<u>CSEA Report</u> - Mr. Tony Garcia, CSEA President, was not present to report at this time.

ASB Report - Mr. Willie Lee, Student Trustee, was not present to report at this time.

<u>West Hills College Coalinga and North District Center, Firebaugh</u> – Dr. Anthony Tricoli, President, distributed a campus activities report and briefly commented on recent and upcoming events. Dr. Tricoli provided a presentation on his recruiting trip to Sweden and Italy last November.

Dr. Beverly Smith, Dean of Student Learning, provided an update on the accreditation process for West Hills College Coalinga. She discussed areas of potential weakness and areas of strength.

<u>West Hills College Lemoore</u> – Mr. Don Warkentin, Interim President, distributed a campus activities report and briefly commented on recent and upcoming events. He provided a brief slide presentation on Mr. Tony Oliveira's trip to the State Capitol.

<u>Chancellor's Report</u> – At this time Dr. Frank Gornick introduced Mr. Ray Cowles, auditor for the District.

FS-34 Auditor's Report – Mr. Ray Cowles of Vavrinek, Trine, Day & Company presented the District's audit report for 2003-2004. He explained the audit report and the executive summary. Dr. Gornick thanked Mr. Cowles for providing the executive summary for the Board of Trustees in advance of the Board meeting as it allowed them time to review the document prior to the presentation.

The auditor's report for 2003-2004 was approved on a motion by Trustee Levinson, seconded by Trustee Minnite, and carried unanimously.

Dr. Gornick introduced Mr. Bill Skinner, Community Development Director for the City of Coalinga. Mr. Skinner provided a presentation on the school farm master plan and discussed the mixed use development of the property.

Dr. Gornick provided a presentation on the policy and procedure review process for the District.

Ms. Susan Kincade provided a presentation with regard to online instruction.

CONSENT AGENDA

The following consent agenda items were approved on a motion by Trustee Levinson, seconded by Trustee Ivans, and carried unanimously:

- CO-16 Curriculum Committee Action Report, West Hills College Coalinga The Curriculum Committee Action Report, Fall 2004 for West Hills College Coalinga was presented for a first reading. Approval will be requested at a future meeting of the Board of Trustees.
- CO-17 New Curriculum Dr. Gornick reported that Dr. Tricoli and his staff have been working very hard on the Hospital Peace Officer Training Academy project with the Coalinga State Hospital. Dr. Tricoli reported that the program is scheduled to begin the second week of April.

The curriculum for AOJ 56, Hospital Peace Officer Training Academy, was approved on a motion by Trustee Ivans, seconded by Trustee Oxborrow, and carried unanimously.

CO-18 Board Policies and Administrative Procedures – President McKean questioned Board Policy 7210, Employment of Academic Employees and brief discussion occurred regarding the last paragraph.

Brief discussion took place regarding Board Policy 7130, Compensation and it was explained that the policy deals with compensation, not hiring.

- FS-35 TRANs Resolution The resolution in the matter of the District's participation in the 2005-2006 Piper-Jaffray California Cash Reserve Program (Tax and Revenue Anticipation Notes TRANs) was approved on a motion by Trustee Levinson, seconded by Trustee Minnite, and carried unanimously.

FS-36 <u>Substitution of Site-Plumbing Contractor</u> – Mr. Stoppenbrink reported that Bush Construction has agreed to take over the project from Mauldin-Dorfmeier and the agreement has been signed.

The substitution of the site utilities subcontractor for the West Hills College Lemoore, Phase 2B Initial Buildings Project was approved on a motion by Trustee Minnite, seconded by Trustee Ivans, and carried unanimously.

FS-37 <u>Change Order</u> – Trustee Ivans questioned the timeline for the West Hills College Coalinga Library Expansion project. Dr. Gornick stated that we are on time with the project. Discussion occurred regarding the implementation of alternate work.

The following change order was approved on a motion by Trustee Levinson, seconded by Trustee Ivans, and carried on the following votes: Ayes – 6; Noes – 1 (Trustee Minnite).

Trustee Oxborrow thanked everyone for their hard work. She stated that accreditation is hard work but she has faith that we have a good team.

Trustee Henry stated that financial reports have always been difficult to understand but thanked Ken for his explanations. He stated that the audit report was good. Trustee Henry expressed his thanks for the tremendous amount of work done on accreditation.

Trustee Levinson echoed the comments made by his fellow Board members.

President McKean stated that our reserves are growing and it is a credit to the management that comes in every day.

President McKean announced that the next meeting of the Governing Board is scheduled for March 8, 2005.
